

KEEP BAKERSFIELD BEAUTIFUL COMMITTEE

The Keep Bakersfield Beautiful Committee (KBBC) is an advisory body to the City Council. It is composed of eight (8) board members and eight (8) alternate members appointed by the Mayor and City Council. The Mayor and each Councilmember nominate resident of the City of Bakersfield, and nominations are approved by the full Council.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Municipal Code Section 2.62

TERM: Term runs concurrent with the nominating Councilmember's and Mayor's terms of office. Appointments are made in November.

QUALIFICATIONS: Members must be residents of the City throughout their term.

DUTIES: The Keep Bakersfield Beautiful Committee recommends policies and specific programs to the City Council which promote the mission statement of the KBBC as reflected in its bylaws. The KBBC actively participates in the implementation of various programs and projects to achieve the KBBC mission statement.

Alternate members attend in the stead of the Board member and only have voting rights when the Board member is absent.

MEETINGS: Meetings are held on the second Friday of each month at 12:00 noon, in the Solid Waste Conference Room, City of Bakersfield Corporation Yard, 4101 Truxtun Avenue.
